### **APPENDIX**

The main offence types are shown in the main body of the audit. The following tables break down the offences into sub groups which have been commented on in the main body too.

The total number of offences varies slightly from the totals in the main body for the following reasons.

The statistics change on a daily basis as some offences are reported or admitted some time after the event and it is not uncommon to record an offence today that happened in 2002. An example of this may be a prison clear up when a suspect admits offences from a number of years ago.

Another reason for the variation is that the police statistics are collated at headquarters and they are given an offence code. There is a small number of offences that appear in the tables but have not been given an offence code, and so when the searches were done on the system, some offences would not have been called up.

Likewise you can see that in the table for criminal damage you see burglary and thefts albeit very few in number. The explanation for this is that originally the offence would have been recorded as a damage but it has since been reclassified to another offence. For some reason this still remains on the system under the original offence.

The first 4 tables are different from the others in that they contain the beat code i.e G11A. These relate to the wards as follows.

- G11D – Old Harlow
